

SPACE SIZES: Show spots are 6 feet wide by 9 feet deep (6' x 9'). Please note that show displays for entries are not allowed. However, informational, credit, sponsor, or company signs are welcomed & encouraged! There are a limited number of show spots available that feature aisle corner/end cap locations (which are ideal for improved spectator viewing). They are sold on a first come / first served basis. Double show spots are also available for entries that are oversized. They measure twelve feet wide by nine feet deep (12' x 9'). Sorry, aisle corner/end cap spots are not available with double show spots. Check (☑) on the Official 2006 Bike Show Entry Form the show spot option that best suites your show needs. Please be aware that due to circumstances beyond our control, such as placement of fire exit doors, building configurations, etc., some show spots may not be their exact full size. In these remote instances, we request exhibitors to please be flexible. Exhibitors are reminded that their entry fees are buying a show spot for competition/awards, more so, than an exact square footage of floor space. However, upon setting up at the show, if you should find your show spot to be inadequate and/or quite impossible to accommodate your entry, *please* bring the matter to our attention, at which time we will attempt to solve the situation. To facilitate the best possible floor plan and help avoid such situations – arrangements for aisle corner/end cap spots, double show spots, etc., must be made in advance by indicating, as such, on the bike show entry form. Please state any other special needs, concerns, or requests (like having your spot/location next to a friend's), not specifically addressed on the bike show application that may, as a result, have an affect on our floor planning and/or your actual show spot location.

**SHOW HOURS: Show hours for the 3rd Annual PORKER'S U.S.A. INDOOR BIKE SHOW are as follows:
Saturday, March 11, 2006 → 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM ✕ Sunday, March 12, 2006 → 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.**

SMOKING / ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: As in most public buildings - **SMOKING IS PROHIBITED!** In the show arena, but not limited to the same, this policy is in effect during setup hours, show hours, and tear down. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas or outside the building! No beer, wine, liquor, or other forms of alcoholic beverages are allowed brought into the building. The Ramada Inn Convention Center has complete control of all alcoholic beverages (including food) within the building and will provide them for sale. *Please* cooperate with state and local laws.

SECURITY: *There will be 24-hour building security staff on duty at the show. This security includes Friday night during & after exhibitor setup.*

CONDUCT & SHOW INTEGRITY: Show management and/or the chief show judge reserves the right to prohibit entry, remove, or disqualify any motorcycle and/or exhibitor from the show that does not abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in this OFFICIAL 2006 BIKE SHOW AWARDS, RULES, and INFORMATION GUIDE; or in management's opinion, detracts from the integrity or is not in the best interest of the show. Exhibitors/entries removed from the show under these circumstances will not be eligible for trophies, cash awards, or other premiums and may result in the *forfeiture* of ALL fees and/or denial of future applications for show. Exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in the spirit of the event and display their motorcycles accordingly. *Ensure your awards and future welcome by putting your best wheel forward!*

FIRE & SAFETY: **Batteries must be disconnected and all gas drained from your motorcycle(s) before you enter the building.** Failure to comply with fire and safety regulations will result in loss of judging points or may prevent you from exhibiting your motorcycle(s).

RUNNING OF MOTORCYCLES INSIDE THE BUILDING, AT ANY TIME, IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED!

SETUP HOURS: ALL BIKE SHOW EXHIBITOR SETUP IS ON FRIDAY ONLY (MARCH 10): 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM.

All entry setup & prepping must be completed by 9:00 PM Friday, March 10th. Motorcycles must be left uncovered, bike show identification cards posted, and exhibitors out of the building by the close of setup hours, as classification and judging of entries immediately begins at this time. *Failure to comply will result in loss of judging points!*

EXHIBITOR CHECK IN: Exhibitors are expected to check in for registrant verification at least one hour prior to the close of setup hours, or in other words by 8:00 PM. Unless notification is given and received, failure to comply will indicate that exhibitor is a "no show" and a standby entrant may be accepted in his or her place. Upon such occurrences, forfeiture of entry fee(s) may result (per the discretion of show management). In addition, please understand that exhibitors can only be and are checked in - *one at a time*. Consequently, you may expect and/or experience a delay getting into the building. This may affect not only your check in time, but also (reduce) the amount of time remaining/available to you for completing your entry setup on time (by 9:00 PM on Friday). In consideration of this and/or other contingencies, *please* budget your travel and setup time, accordingly, in order to satisfy all expectations concerned.

BIKE SHOW IDENTIFICATION CARDS: Bike Show Identification Cards will be furnished to all exhibitors upon checking in for show setup on Friday. These yellow 8.5" x 11" cards are extremely important as they are used by our show judges for identification, classification, and judging purposes. In addition, show spectators require them in order to vote (for your entry) on show day(s). **Your Bike Show Identification Card must be visibly posted within your designated show space and next to your motorcycle by the time you leave the building after completing your entry setup on FRIDAY.** Failure to comply with this requirement does not win favor with our show judges, as it greatly delays them in the performance of their responsibilities and *will result in loss of judging points or may even prevent your entry from being scored and as a result – taking you out of show competition.* Each exhibitor should also review this identification card, during setup on Friday, to ensure that all information written on it is correct. If anything is in error, please bring it to the attention of one of our show judges or event staff at the check in table. Exhibitors are not to correct or write anything on the card themselves. *Please* - do not tape the card to the floor, wedge it under a tire or some other part of your motorcycle, or make it stick to any surface at any time. Once again, just **leave your show identification card on the floor immediately next to your motorcycle before you leave the building after completing your setup on Friday.** *Your cooperation in this matter is extremely important and is greatly appreciated.*

DISPLAY SIGNS: Display, informational, credit, sponsor(s) and/or company signs are welcomed and encouraged. Keep in mind, though, that these signs should enhance your motorcycle for show competition and not detract from it. *Limit 'For Sale' signs to 8" x 10".*

TENDING DISPLAYS: It is suggested that exhibitors periodically check their entry during the show to ensure that all is in show order. However, we prefer that exhibitors do not sit or lounge within their display area during show hours as spectators, who have paid for admission, desire and are entitled to an unobstructed view of the show bikes.

AWARDS PRESENTATIONS: **The bike show awards presentations will begin at, approximately, 3:30 PM Sunday, March 12.** In order to maintain schedules and present all the awards in a timely fashion - we ask exhibitors to please make themselves available and be in the vicinity of the stage at the applicable time. Listen up for your entry number and name to be called to receive your award(s) and possible photo instructions.

SHOW RESULTS: We understand and appreciate our exhibitors' competitive natures; moreover, all their investments in the form of time, money, and hard work in their respective show entries. It is this kind of dedication, spirit, enthusiasm, and/or desire to win that truly accounts for the excellent and outstanding quality of motorcycles displayed at Porker's U.S.A. Bike Shows. However, we encourage exhibitors to understand and appreciate the level of competition and that their desire to win, considering all investments made, is shared - you can be sure - by most if not all of the other exhibitors as well. *Please* try to reflect a positive attitude or outlook if our judges' findings (show results/standings) do not meet with your immediate and/or personal expectations. However, if you believe that a mistake was made regarding show results, *please* bring the matter to our attention immediately after the awards presentations when the judges, all bike show paperwork (classing, judging, and/or award forms) and the motorcycle(s) in question are still present. It is difficult, if not impossible, to double-check or investigate issues, much more to say yet - render (satisfactory) explanations to exhibitors' inquiries that come by letter or over the phone days after the event, when show judges, paperwork, and motorcycles are not all available simultaneously. Under the most favorable circumstances, i.e. immediately after the awards presentations, we will be glad to investigate or double-check matters and render an explanation to your inquiry or position. If, indeed, an honest mistake or oversight was made - every attempt will be made to remedy the situation, if not immediately, and with all apologies.

TEAR DOWN: Exhibitors are expected to keep their motorcycles uncovered and displays intact Sunday (3-12-06) until the close of show hours (5:00 PM). The awards presentations may end prior to 5:00 PM; nevertheless, **exhibitors have an obligation to the show and the general public and are not allowed to tear down displays or attempt to move bikes prior to the end of show hours.** When you do depart, *please* - do not leave excessive debris behind in the exhibit area.
